“Supporting Refugees with Disabilities in Cincinnati”

Requirements:

- Familiarity and/or experience with the Cincinnati refugee community
- Reliable and mature; takes initiative and works independently
- Interest in or experience working with people with disabilities and their families
- Available 16-20 hrs/week; January 2019-December 2019; daytime hours (Mon-Fri); some evenings and weekends possible; some local travel may be required
- Ability to communicate effectively with/to different audiences
- Fellowship site(s) will be at Cincinnati Children’s Hospital, Medical Office Building, and in the community

Responsibilities:

- Case management support for refugee families with disabilities
- Develop content to help refugee families navigate and find disability-related resources
- Collaborate with the Cincinnati Pediatric Refugee Health Consortium
- Other tasks as assigned

- Gaining knowledge of developmental disabilities, refugee communities, and public policy
- Workings of a non-profit organization with focus on developmental disabilities
- Providing community education and family support; creating informational materials
- Paid travel opportunities to present work at the completion of the fellowship
